Mascoma Community Health Center Dental Clinic October Reopening

Starting on October 2, Mascoma Health Center in Canaan will again be serving the community with quality dental care. We will begin taking appointments and registering patients in September. To schedule an appointment, call 603-523-4343. We will start seeing patients on October 2, 2023.

The suspension of our dental services in July of 2022 due to loss of our dentist to private practice has made it difficult for more than a thousand patients to receive appropriate dental care. Despite a statewide shortage of dentists, and six months of searching, we have succeeded in hiring a highly competent dental staff. Our dentists are skilled across the entire field of dentistry. They will focus on preventive care and provide services regardless of the patient's insurance or income.

We are now ready to reopen!

From the start, in October we will have <u>2 dentists and 2 hygienists</u> to assure continuity and allow for patient growth. We intend to:

- <u>Offer a fully digital practice</u> to provide the highest quality of care and efficient, convenient service. This will mean the ability to provide rapid, on-site, perfect fitting dental pieces like crowns and caps.
- <u>Offer all levels of services</u> from cleaning to rehabilitation including crowns, caps, root canals and implants. It is our goal to offer endodontics and oral surgery within 12 months.
- Provide <u>expert pediatric dental care</u>.
- Assure safe and effective care with no or minimal pain.
- Hire people with <u>excellent professional credentials and experience</u> providing care to underserved populations.
- Work with educational partners to create or <u>support upper New England schools to train dentists</u>, <u>oral</u> <u>surgeons</u>, <u>endodontists</u>, <u>ics</u>, <u>pediatric dentists</u>, <u>and dental hygienists</u>.
